**DECISION OF THE SUB COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL
ACCREDITATION BODY (NAB) UNDER NPOP**

The Sub Committee of The National Accreditation Body (NAB) under NPOP in its meeting held on 10th and 26th September 2025, has taken the following decisions:

Certification Bodies:

1. Accreditation of **Eccentric Organic Private Limited** under NPOP has been terminated and the directors of Eccentric Organic Private Limited have been blacklisted for three years for severe non-compliances in the certification process under NPOP.
2. Accreditation of **Global Certification Society (GCS)** under NPOP has been suspended for one year along with pecuniary penalty of Rs. Five lakhs for serious non-compliances in the certification process under NPOP.
3. Accreditation of **Natural Organic Certification Agency (NOCA)** under NPOP has been suspended for one year along with pecuniary penalty of Rs. Five lakhs for serious non-compliances in the certification process under NPOP.
4. Accreditation of **Krushhi Certification Pvt. Ltd.** under NPOP has been suspended for one year along with pecuniary penalty of Rs. Five lakhs for serious non-compliances under in the certification process under NPOP.
5. The Scope of Accreditation of **Bihar State Seed and Organic Certification Agency (BSSOCA)** has been restricted to only Bihar State along with pecuniary penalty of Rs. Five lakhs for major non-compliances in the certification process under NPOP.
6. Pecuniary penalty of Rs. Ten Lakhs imposed on **Uttarakhand State Organic Certification Agency (USOCA)**. The restriction on Scope Accreditation of USOCA to only Uttarakhand State, imposed by Order of Penalty dated

23.04.2025 to be implemented with immediate effect and the derogation regarding transfer of operators before next renewal withdrawn for major non-compliances in the certification process under NPOP.

Exporter:

1. The certification under NPOP of **M/s Aadroit Indulgence Pvt. Ltd.**, has been suspended till hearing of the matter and the final decision by the Sub Committee/NAB for major non-compliances and violation of NPOP.
